



**Brother Joseph (Terence NOLAN)**  
**(1923 - 1995)**

*Died 7 September 1995, in London (England)  
aged 72, with 51 years of Religious Profession.*

Terence Nolan was born in Liverpool on 6 August 1923. After four years of studies at Romsey, he entered the noviciate (Totton) in 1943 and made his first profession on 19 March 1944, taking the religious name of Brother Joseph.

He spent the first part of his religious life at Montfort College (Romsey). With the close of that house, several communities had the pleasure of having him among their members: Highgate, Kilburn, Andover, the scholasticate (Hendon), Monaghan (Ireland), and the provincial house.

He was a man for every service, always joyful... Everyone knew Brother Joseph, who was a welcoming person, always smiling and humming...

Since last year, he had been living in a care home run by the Sisters of Nazareth in Hammersmith, London. It is the place where he died, on 7 September last.
